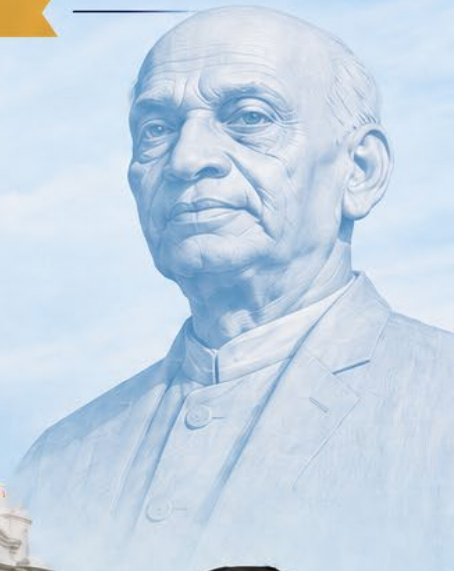

New Admission Age Criteria for Pre-Nursery to 2nd Class

According to the Madhya Pradesh Government / NEP-based guidelines, the age criteria for pre-primary classes are generally as follows:

Class	Minimum Age	Maximum Age
Pre-Nursery	2 Years	3 Years
Nursery	3 Years	4 Years 6 Months
LKG (KG-1)	4 Years	5 Years 6 Months
UKG (KG-2)	5 Years	6 Years 6 Months

Note:

- Age is usually calculated as on **31st July** or as per the school/RTE notification of the academic session 2026-27.
- These criteria are based on the Madhya Pradesh School Education Department guidelines aligned with NEP 2020.

TRANSFER CERTIFICATE (TC) RULES

- Parents must submit a written application for issuance of TC.
- TC will be issued after verification of school records and completion of necessary formalities.
- Kindly ensure that all dues and school materials are cleared before applying.
- Duplicate TC can be issued on request with applicable charges.
- Processing time for TC may take minimum 7days and maximum 15 working days.
- All corrections in TC must be supported by valid documents.

Fee Discount Policy

वार्षिक शुल्क भुगतान के नियम एवं शर्तें)Annual Fee Rules & Regulations)

1. वार्षिक शुल्क पर छूट)Annual Fee Payment Discount)

- 30 अप्रैल से पहले:** जो अभिभावक (Parents) 30 अप्रैल से पहले पूरे वर्ष की फीस एक साथ जमा करते हैं, उन्हें कुल फीस पर **10% की छूट** दी जाएगी।
- 31 जुलाई से पहले:** जो अभिभावक 31 जुलाई से पहले पूरे वर्ष की फीस एक साथ जमा करते हैं, उन्हें कुल फीस पर **5% की छूट** दी जाएगी।

2. भाईबहन के लिए- छूट)Sibling Discount)

- दूसरा बच्चा: यदि एक ही माता-पिता के दो बच्चे स्कूल में पढ़ रहे हैं, तो दूसरे बच्चे को ट्यूशन फीस (Tuition Fee) पर **15% की छूट** मिलेगी।
- तीसरा या उससे अधिक बच्चा: यदि स्कूल में दो से अधिक बच्चे पढ़ रहे हैं, तो तीसरे बच्चे और उसके बाद के बच्चों को ट्यूशन फीस पर **25% की छूट** दी जाएगी।

3. महत्वपूर्ण सूचना)Important Notes & Policies)

- छूट की अंतिम तिथि: सभी प्रकार की छूट (Discounts) केवल तभी मान्य होंगी जब फीस **31 दिसंबर** से पहले जमा कर दी जाएगी। यदि दिसंबर के अंत तक फीस पूरी तरह जमा नहीं होती है, तो कोई भी छूट लागू नहीं होगी।
- अप्रतिदेय शुल्क (Non-Refundable Policy): स्कूल में एक बार जमा किया गया शुल्क (Payment) किसी भी परिस्थिति में वापस (Refund) नहीं किया जाएगा।
- CBSE बोर्ड शुल्क (CBSE Board Fees): कक्षा 9वीं में रजिस्ट्रेशन (Registration Fee) और कक्षा 10वीं में परीक्षा फॉर्म (Exam Form Fee) की राशि अलग से ली जाएगी। यह फीस CBSE के नियमानुसार देय होगी।
- विलंब शुल्क / पेनल्टी (Late Fee Penalty): यदि फीस की किस्त (Installment) निर्धारित समय पर जमा नहीं की जाती है, तो अंतिम तिथि के बाद **10 रुपये प्रतिदिन** के हिसाब से विलंब शुल्क (Penalty) लगाया जाएगा।

Bus Fee Rules

- Bus fee will be charged according to the **distance covered**.

. Bus Fee Revision: In the event of extreme fuel price hikes caused by war or any other global/national emergency, the school management reserves the right to revise and increase the bus fee accordingly.

Admission Fee Rules

At the time of admission, it is mandatory for parents to pay:

- Registration Fee
- Admission Fee
- First Installment of Tuition Fee

Kindly ensure timely payment of fees to avoid inconvenience.

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP) FOR STUDENTS

1. School Timings

- Students must reach the school before the reporting time.
- Late arrival without a valid reason may lead to disciplinary action.
- Students should attend school regularly and punctually.

2. School Uniform

- Students must wear a neat and complete school uniform every day.
- Shoes, socks, ID cards, belts, and other prescribed items are compulsory.
- Hair should be clean and properly groomed.
- Fancy hairstyles, jewelry, nail polish, and makeup are not allowed.

3. Discipline and Behavior

- Students must behave respectfully with teachers, staff, and fellow students.
- Use of abusive language, fighting, bullying, or misbehavior is strictly prohibited.
- Students must maintain silence and discipline during class hours and assemblies.
- Damage to school property will result in penalties or compensation.

4. Attendance Rules

- A minimum attendance percentage as prescribed by the school must be maintained.
 - Leave applications must be submitted by parents in advance whenever possible.
 - In case of sickness, a medical certificate may be required.
 - Students absent without information may not be allowed to attend classes until clarification.

5. Classroom Rules

- Students must carry required books, notebooks, and stationery daily.
 - Homework and assignments must be completed on time.
 - Students should seek permission before leaving the classroom.
 - Eating during class hours is not permitted.

6. Examination Rules

- Students must follow all examination instructions carefully.
 - Any unfair means or cheating during exams will lead to strict disciplinary action.
 - Absence during examinations must be supported by a valid reason and approved by school authorities.

7. Use of Mobile Phones and Electronic Gadgets

- Mobile phones, smart watches, earphones, and electronic gadgets are not allowed in school unless permitted by the school authority.
 - Confiscated items will only be returned to parents.
-

8. Cleanliness and Hygiene

- Students must maintain personal hygiene and keep classrooms clean.
 - Throwing waste outside dustbins is strictly prohibited.
 - Students should help maintain the cleanliness of the school campus.
-

9. Safety Rules

- Running in corridors, pushing, or unsafe behavior is not allowed.
 - Students should immediately report any injury, bullying, or unsafe situation to teachers.
 - Strict instructions given during emergencies or drills must be followed.
-

10. Transport Rules

- Students using school transport must follow bus discipline.
 - Students should remain seated while the bus is moving.
 - Misbehavior in the school bus may result in suspension of transport facility.

11. Library and Laboratory Rules

- Silence must be maintained in the library and laboratories.
 - Students are responsible for borrowed books and laboratory equipment.
 - Any damage or loss must be compensated.

12. Parent Communication

- Parents should communicate with teachers only during the prescribed timings.
 - Parents should attend the PTM regularly to know the student progress.

13. Prohibited Items

Students are not allowed to bring:

- Sharp objects
 - Crackers or harmful materials
 - Expensive items
 - Unauthorized electronic gadgets

14. General Instructions

- Respect school values and maintain good conduct at all times.
- Students must participate actively in school activities.
- The school reserves the right to take disciplinary action for violation of school rules.

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP) FOR PARENTS

1. School Timings and Entry Rules

- Parents are requested to follow the school visiting timings strictly.
 - Parents should enter the school premises only after permission from the office/security.
 - Unnecessary visits during teaching hours should be avoided.

2. Communication with Teachers

- Parents may meet Class Teachers or Subject Teachers only during the prescribed timings.
 - Parents are requested not to disturb teachers during class hours.
 - Phone calls to teachers should be made only during the approved timing.
-

3. Attendance and Leave

- Parents should ensure regular attendance of their child.
 - Leave applications must be submitted in writing whenever possible.
 - In case of illness, a medical certificate may be required.
-

4. Fee Payment Rules

- School fees must be paid according to the prescribed installment schedule.
 - Parents are requested to clear all dues on time to avoid inconvenience.
 - Discounts and concessions will be applicable only as per school rules.
-

5. Student Discipline

- Parents should cooperate with the school in maintaining discipline.
- Students should come to school in proper uniform and with required study materials.
- Parents are requested to counsel their children regarding respectful behavior.

6. Transport Rules

- Parents should ensure the timely pickup and drop-off of students at their nearest designated stop.
- Bus route and transport rules must be followed strictly.
- Any transport-related concern should be reported to the school office.

7. Safety and Security

- Parents must carry valid identification when required.
- No student will be handed over to unauthorized persons without prior permission from parents.
- Parents should immediately inform the school about any change in address or contact number.

8. Health and Hygiene

- Sick children should not be sent to school.
- Parents should inform the school regarding any medical condition or allergies of the child.
- Students should maintain personal hygiene and cleanliness.
- **Promoting Healthy Eating:** Parents/Guardians are requested to provide only nutritious, healthy, and home-cooked food in their child's Tiffin.
- **Strict Ban on Junk Food:** Please avoid sending any kind of junk food, packed snacks, or deep-fried items, as the school strictly promotes a healthy lifestyle and proper nutrition for all students.

9. School Property

- Parents are responsible for any damage caused by their child to school property.
 - Books, ID cards, uniforms, and school belongings should be maintained properly.

10. Social Media and Conduct

- Parents are requested to use respectful language while communicating with school staff.
 - Misleading information or inappropriate comments regarding the school on social media should be avoided.
 - Any concern should first be discussed with the school administration.

11. Examination and Academic Support

- Parents should regularly monitor homework, class work, and academic progress.
 - Attendance during examinations is compulsory unless there is a valid reason.
 - Parents are encouraged to attend PTMs and school meetings regularly.
 - Parents are requested to regularly monitor their child's academic progress and ensure that they complete their homework on a daily basis.

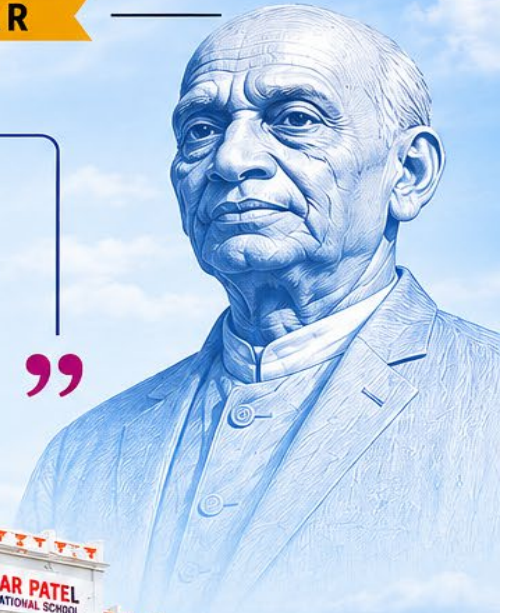
